## Webpage—Reference Elements (author same as website name)

### 1. Author

- Separate names with &
- Note the commas, spaces, and full stops
- Include additional identifiers (e.g., Jr., Sr., III)
- Do not include qualifications (e.g., PhD, MD) and titles (e.g., Rev, Sir)

### 2. Publication Year

- In brackets
- Full stop

### 3. Title

- First word of title, subtitles, and proper nouns have a capital letter
- Italics
- Full stop

### 4. Source

- Website name (omit if same as author)
- Webpage URL
- No full stop

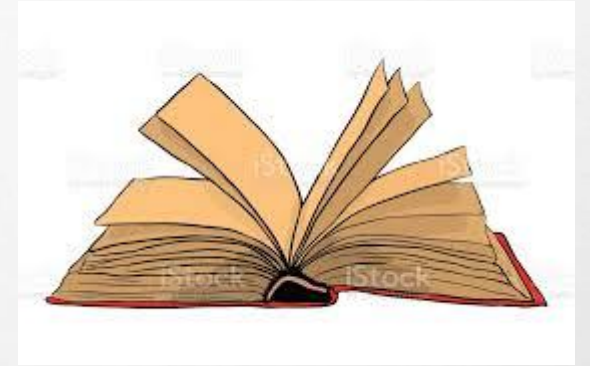
